The Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Managament Agency (FRMA), intends to coordinate all disaster relief efforts that have the purpose of alloviating the handship and suffering caused by the emergency on the local population and to provide appropriate seniatance for required emergency measures, authorized under Title V of the Stafford Act, to save lives, protect public health and safety, protect property, or to lesson or avert the threat of a catastrophe in the designated arcss. Specifically, FEMA is authorized to provide debris removal and emergency protective measures (Categories A and B), including direct Federal assistance, under the Public Assistance program. Any Federal funds for Public Assistance will be limited to 75 percent of the total eligible costs.

FEMA will coordinate Federal assistance offerts and designate specific areas eligible for such assistance. The Federal Coordinating Officer will be Mr. Rea Sherman of FEMA. He will consult with you and assist in the execution of the FEMA-State Agreement for emergency assistance governing the expanditure of Federal funds.
