

Welcome to the WYOMING CENTENNIAL BYWAY FALLS DAY USE AREA

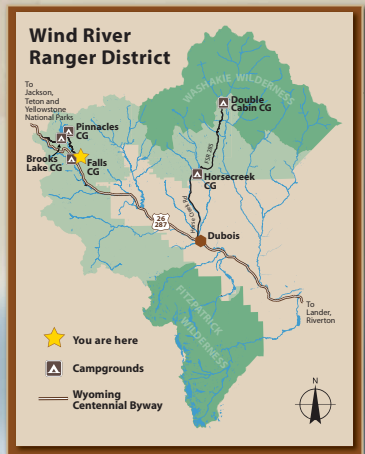
