Dear Mr. Williams:

The Postal Service filed its Annual Report on Form 10-K with the Commission on November 26, 2008, pursuant to the Postal Accountability and Enhancement Act.

The Postal Service now has determined that the Operating Statistics information on page 62 of the filed Annual Report on Form 10-K contained a small number of very minor, inadvertent and immaterial errors. Specifically, with respect to Fiscal Year 2006, the weight for First-Class Mail was 4,538.0 and has been changed to 4,418.1. Similarly, the weight for US Mail was 34.5 and has been changed to 128.1, and the weight for Free Matter for the Blind was 9.1 and has been changed to 35.4. The totals on page 62 do not change.

In order to note the correction of these immaterial errors, the Postal Service is now filing with the Commission an original and two copies of the following:

Annual Report 10-K "containing the information prescribed in Form 10-K of the Securities and Exchange Commission" (39 U.S.C. § 3654(a) (1) (B)), with a revised and corrected page 62.

We have also enclosed a disk with a machine-readable version of the entire report, as corrected.
