Special Restrictions
Fort Fizzle Historical Site and Adjacent Lands

Missoula Ranger District, Lolo National Forest
Missoula County, Montana

Pursuant to the Regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) the following acts are prohibited within the Fort Fizzle Historical Site on the Lolo National Forest. These regulations are in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, and become effective when signed, and will remain in effect until rescinded or revoked. This order supersedes the Order of May 22, 1987, for the Fort Fizzle Historical Site.

PROHIBITED ACTS

36 CFR 261.52 – Fire:

It is prohibited to possess, discharge or use any kind of firework or other pyrotechnic device (36 CFR 261.52 (f)).

36 CFR 261.56 – Use of Vehicles Off National Forest System Roads:

It is prohibited to possess or use any type of vehicle in cross country travel or off National Forest System Roads. (Title 36 CFR 261.56.)

36 CFR 261.58 – Occupancy and Use:

The Following are prohibited:

1. Overnight camping (36 CFR 261.58 (e))
2. Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of posted instructions (36 CFR 261.58 (g)).
3. Discharging a firearm, air rifle or gas gun (36 CFR 261.58 (m))
4. Using any site within the area by more than 20 people in one group for a picnic or group function without a permit from the Missoula Ranger District (36 CFR 261.58 (f)).

5. To go into or be upon the Fort Fizzle Historic Area between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. (36 CFR 261.58(u)).

Area Description:

Boundaries of the restricted area are shown as hatched on the Fort Fizzle Area Map dated June 19, 2007 as shown on Exhibit A and further described as 116 acres, more or less, located in portions of Section 6, T.11 N., R. 20W., portions of Section 31, T.12 N., R. 20W., portions of Section 1, T.11 N., R.21 W., and portions of Section 36, T. 12N., R.21 W., P.M.M.

EXEMPTIONS

1. Persons with a permit issued by a Forest Officer (36 CFR 261.50 (e) (1)).
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty (36 CFR 261.50 (e) (4)).
