FOREST SUPERVISOR'S ORDER

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on the following National Forest System road on the Lolo National Forest. These restrictions are in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, and will become effective July 8, 2008 12:01 am and will remain in effect until rescinded.

36 CFR 261.54 – National Forest System roads

The following is prohibited:

Being on National Forest System Road (NFSR) #456 (Butler Creek Road) from milepost 6.75 to milepost 7.65 with any type of motorized vehicle, bicycle, horseback, or on foot when gates are closed or signs are posted in accordance with 36 CFR 261.54(a). The purpose of this closure is to protect Forest Road Users from on-going timber harvest and road reconstruction activities associated with the Frenchtown Face Timber Sale.

Exemptions:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this restriction:

- 1. Persons with a permit issued by a forest officer specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Penalty:

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571).
