SPECIAL AREA CLOSURE

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited on the area described in this order and depicted on Exhibit A, within and/or administered by the Gifford Pinchot National Forest, Mount Adams Ranger District, until further notice:

1. Going into or being upon the area affected by the Cold Springs Fire. (36 CFR 261.53(e))

AREA DESCRIPTION:

The following description serves as the exterior boundary and closes all lands encompassed within it as depicted in the unshaded area on attached Exhibit A:

From a point of beginning, at the intersection of National Forest System (NFS) Road 8040 and Morrison Creek Trail #39 in the NE corner of Section 22, T7N, R10E, travel E along the N side of Trail #39 about 2 miles to the Junction of Gotchen Creek Trail #40 then travel SE along the N side of Trail #40 to the junction of NFS Road 8020, then E along the N side of NFS Road 8020 to the NFS Road 8200060 then E along the N side of NFS Road 8200060 to NFS Road 8200 travel E along the N side of NFS Road 8200 about .5 miles to the junction of the NFS Road 8290 turn NE and travel along the NW side of NFS Road 8290 for .25 mile to the Gifford Pinchot National Forest boundary in the SE corner of Section 16, T7N, R11E, then N along the E boundary of the GPNF to Round-the-Mountain Trail #9, then W about 1.5 miles along the N side of Trail #9 to South Climb Trail #183, then S along the E side of Trail #183 to South Climb Trailhead, then NE of NFS Road 8040-550 to Cold Springs Trailhead, then generally SE of NFS Road 8040-500 to junction of NFS Road 8040, then travel S along the E side of NFS Road 8040 about 4 miles to the point of beginning.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer or a member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
