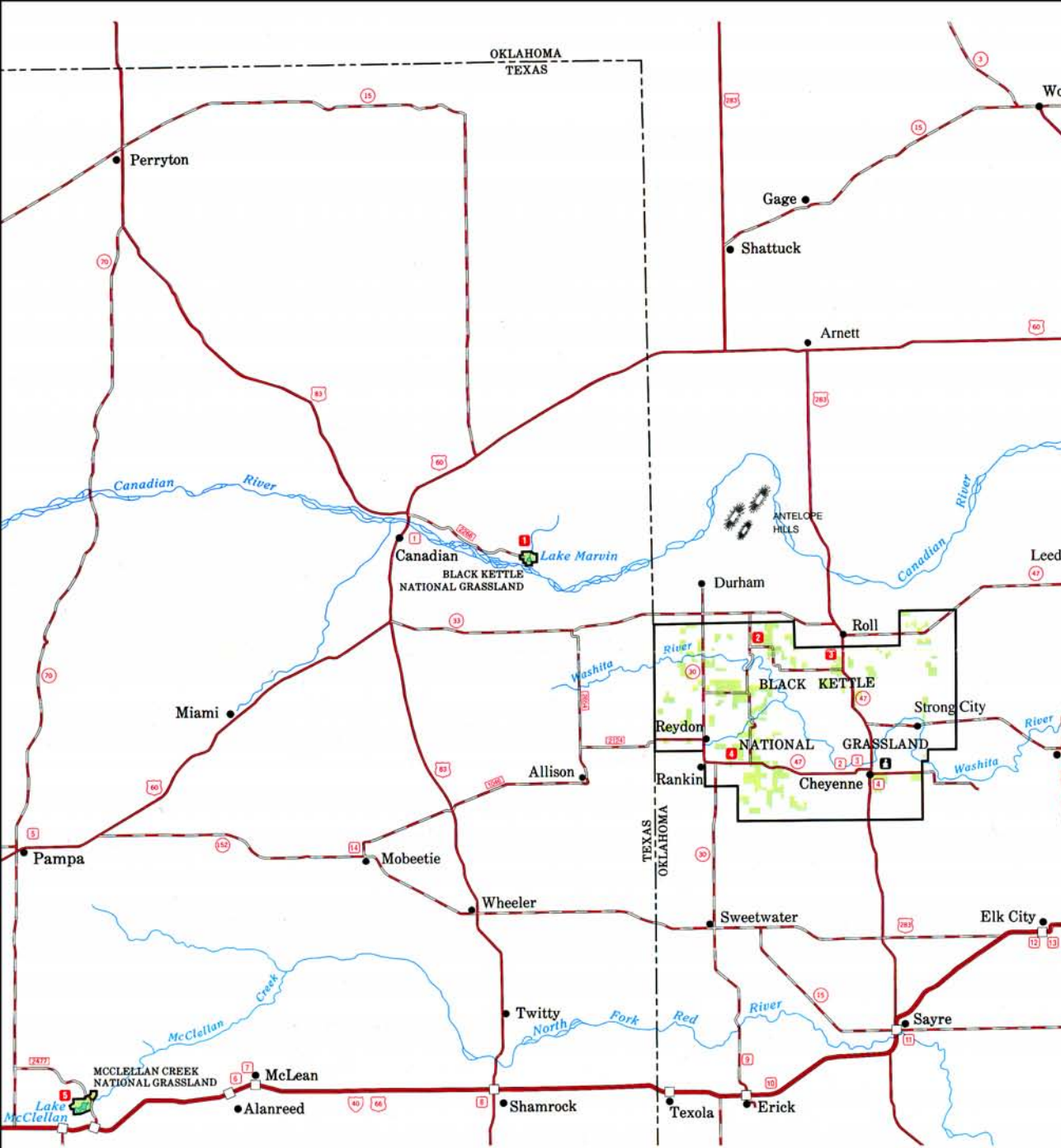


BLACK KETTLE AND MCCLELLAN CREEK NATIONAL GRASSLANDS CIBOLA NATIONAL FOREST
