The District Interdisciplinary Team analyzed the proposed hazardous fuels reduction project under the authorities of the Healthy Forest Restoration Act (HFRA). The HFRA was passed by Congress to provide new tools to Federal agencies so that they can protect communities and their watersheds from wildfire. The response to the objectors dated September 26, 2008 is the final review of this project by any Forest Service or Department of Agriculture official.
