ORDER NO. 96-1

AREAS CLOSED TO VEHICLES ON OR NEAR RAILROAD BUTTES  
NEBRASKA NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to CFR, Sec. 261.50 (a), the following acts are prohibited on the areas shown on Exhibit A of this order on the Buffalo Gap National Grassland until further notice:

Using or possessing a vehicle off forest development roads

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

(1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited acts

(2) Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

The areas closed to vehicles are posted on the ground and described as:

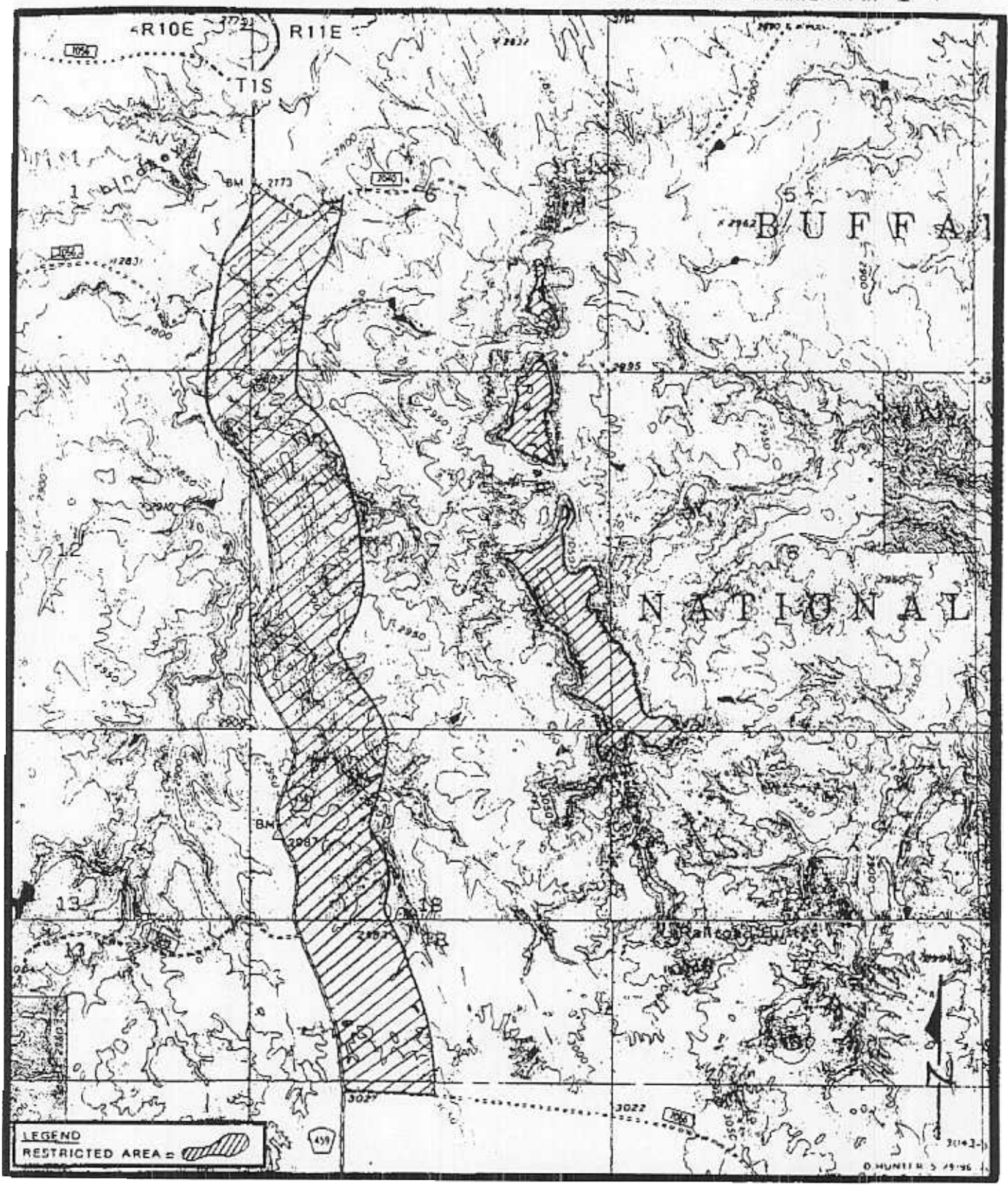
1. Top of Railroad Buttes.

2. An area east of and within 1/4 mile of County Road 21 in the Bennett-Scism allotment in Sec. 6, 7, 8, 17 and 18 T2S R11E and Sec. 1 and 12 T2S R10E.
