The long range goal of Lake of the Woods Vegetation Management Project is to develop a healthy forest for a enjoyable recreational experience.

The preliminary objectives:

• Reduce the number of hazard trees.



- Improve vigor and survivorship of Douglas-fir, ponderosa pine and western white pine.
- Allow root rot centers to convert to grasses, forbs, shrubs and prevent susceptible tree species from becoming established in these areas.
- Plant appropriate tree and shrubs species to perpetuate the forest when openings are created through tree removal.
- Use shrubs and down wood to control traffic patterns, provide visual screening or stabilize eroding surfaces.
