HELP KEEP OUR FORESTS GREEN

Please drown all campfires with water. Make sure all embers, coals and sticks are wet. Move rocks; there may be burning embers underneath. Stir. Add more water and stir again. Feel sticks, charred material, coals and ashes to assure they are cold to the touch. **NO WATER?** Use dirt to smother any embers or fire. **DO NOT** bury it. It may smolder and break through again. Thanks for your care to keep our forests green.

FIREWOOD PERMITS – ON SALE! 4 cords for \$25.00; maximum of ten cords allowed for each household. Permits are available at the Green River Visitor Center, Manila Visitor Center and the Flaming Gorge Resort.

NEW RECREATION FEE PASS CHARGES – The \$35.00 green colored calendar year recreation pass is available at Forest Service Offices as well as the DAILY PASS at \$5.00 and the 7-DAY PASS at \$15.00. FLAMING GORGE RESERVOIR AND GREEN RIVER

Full reservoir is 6,040 feet. Current elevation is 6,021.17 feet. Releases from Flaming Gorge Dam are running about 1500 CFS indefinitely. Green River temperature is approximately 52 degrees.
