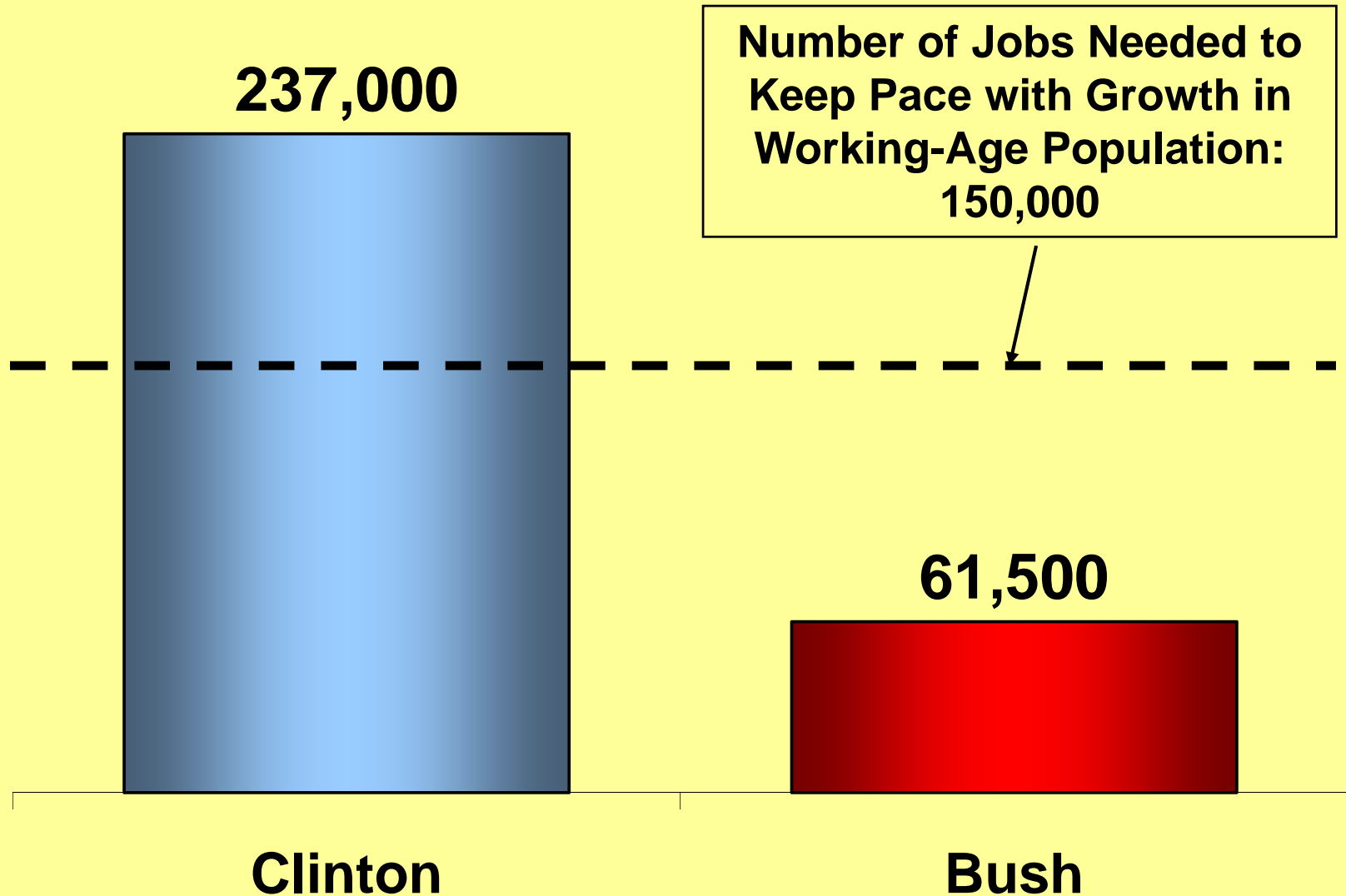


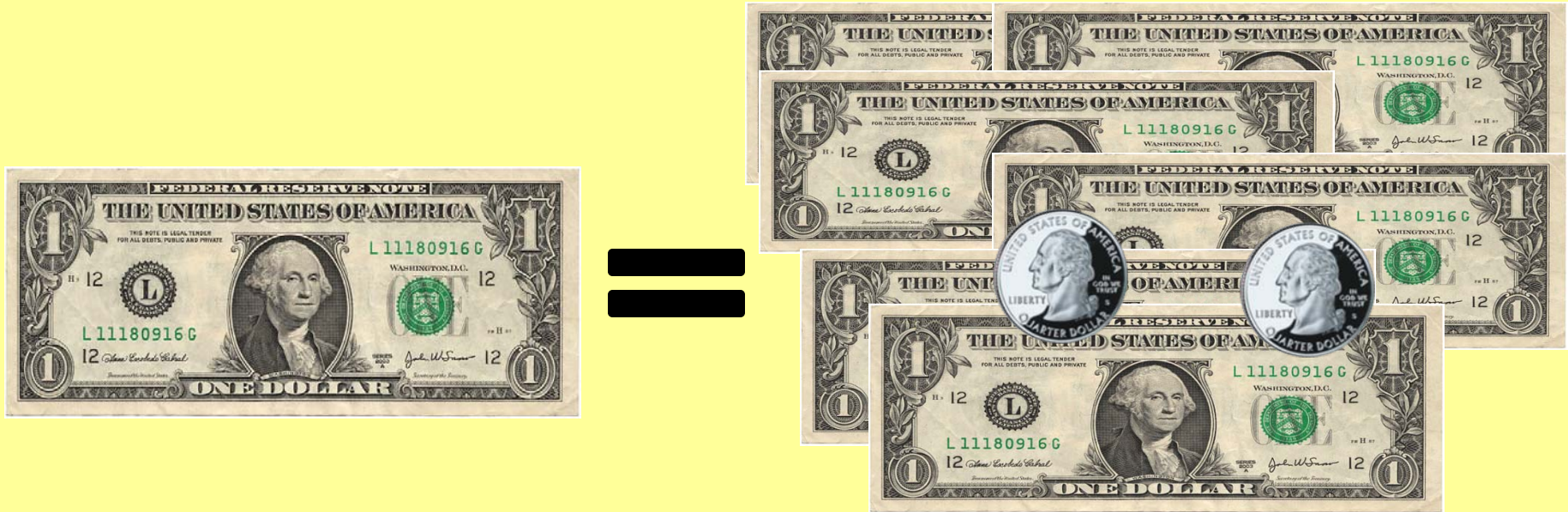
Job Growth Significantly Weaker Under Bush Administration

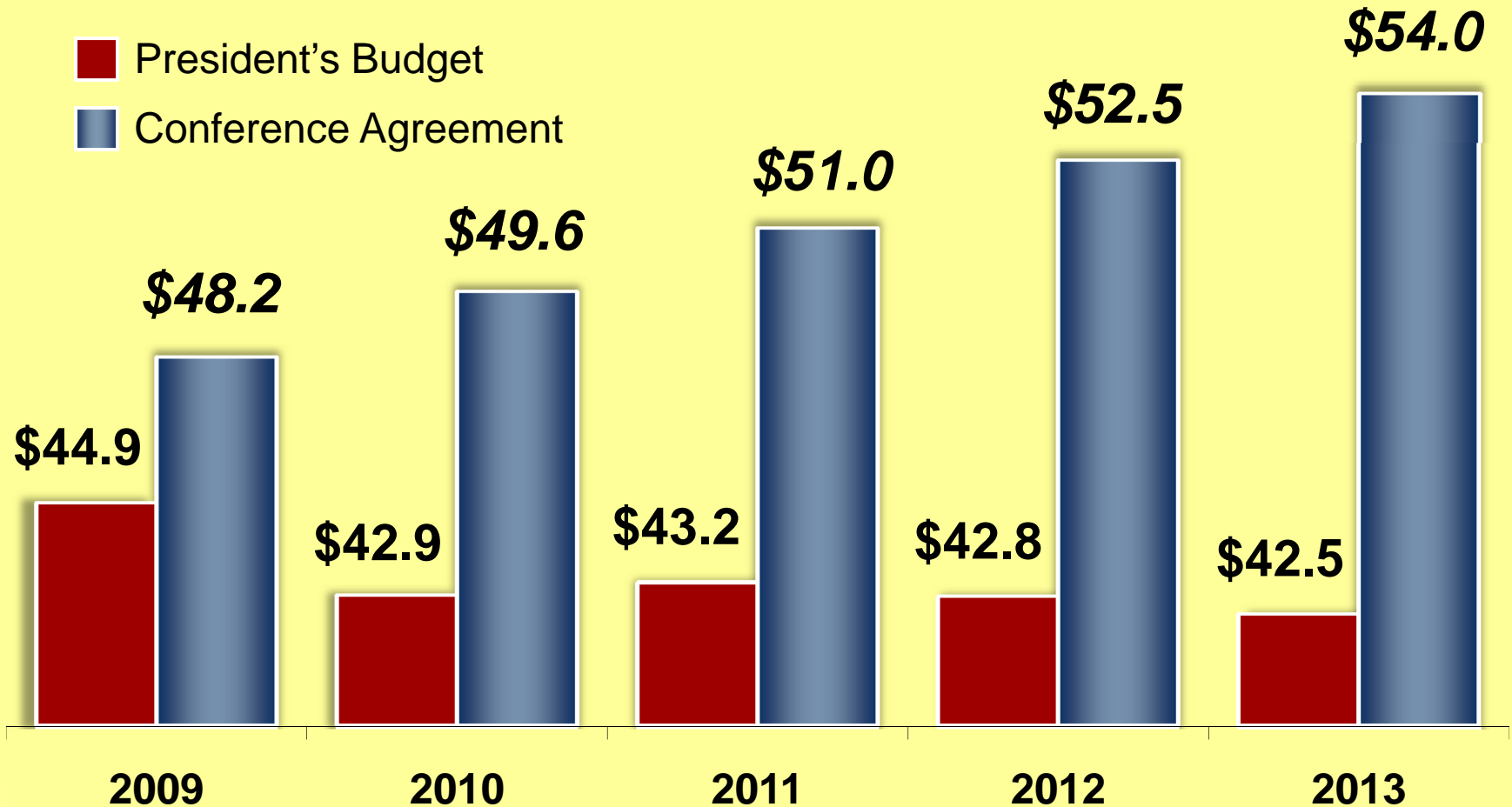

Budget Conference Agreement Provides More Veterans' Funding than President's by \$3 Billion in 2009 and \$39 Billion over Five Years

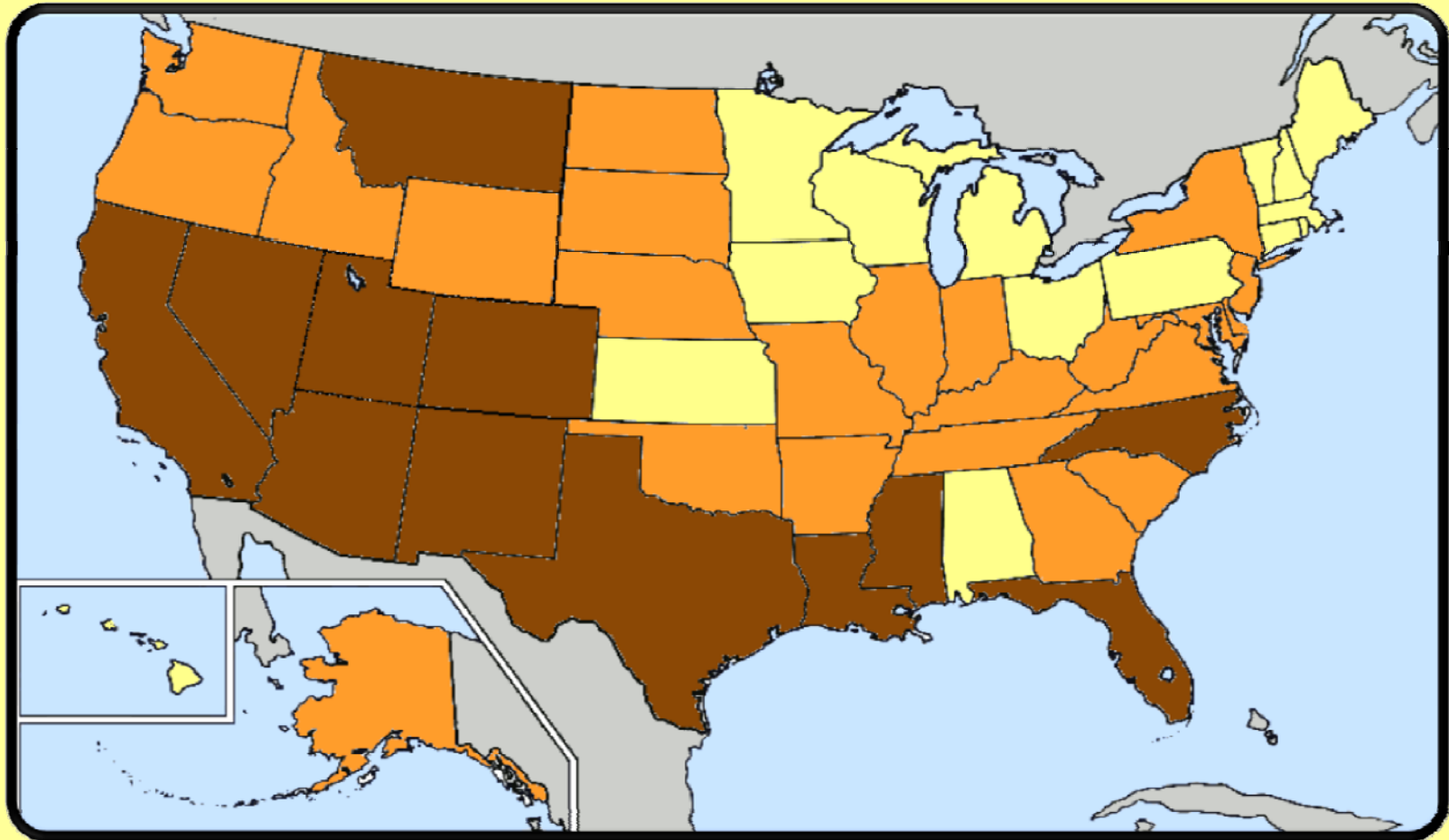


Billions of Dollars in Appropriated Funding
