Logging Activity on Hungry Horse Reservoir Roads, Drive Cautiously

Please use caution when driving along the Hungry Horse Reservoir, both East-Side and West-Side Reservoir Roads, due to Flathead National Forest logging operations in the area. Drivers are encouraged to drive slowly, stay to the right side of road, drive with lights on and obey local area road signage and road personnel.

Logging truck traffic is heavy along the East-Side Reservoir Road, Forest Service Road #38, due to the Spotted Beetle Timber Sale and the Paint Emery Stewardship Project. Logging activity traffic is also taking place on the Meadow Creek Road, Forest Service Road #2826.

The Blackfoot Hazard Tree Salvage Project is taking place along the West-Side Hungry Horse Reservoir Road, Flathead National Forest Service Road #895. Most road-side activity is happening between mile markers 15-21. Logging traffic is also taking place on the Beta Creek Road, Forest Service Road #895H. Traffic delays may be encountered.
