Vandalism at Hungry Horse Ranger Station

The Hungry Horse Ranger Station of the Flathead National Forest in Hungry Horse, Montana was broken into and vandalized the night of Thursday, June 9. Significant damage was sustained to a warehouse and two dirt bikes were stolen. The dirtbikes, 1982 orange Suzuki motorcycles, are valued at approximately \$900 each.

Anyone with information related to this incident may be eligible for a cash reward, up to \$1000 upon arrest and conviction, by contacting Crime Stoppers at 752-8477.
