Flathead National Forest Offers 90 Acres for Public Auction

The Hungry Horse District of the Flathead National Forest in Northwest Montana has approximately 90 acres land available for public purchase through an on-line auction program beginning June 13, 2005. The land and six buildings are located in the town of Hungry Horse, Montana, and have been divided into four parcels ranging from 5 – 42 acres. On-line bids will be accepted for each parcel or as a package purchase. An open house to view the property will be Wednesday, June 15, 1-5pm. Please check in at the Hungry Horse Ranger Station at 8975 Highway 2 East in Hungry Horse, Montana, (located approximately 30 minutes east of Kalispell, Montana).

Funds generated from the land sale will be used to supplement costs to build the new office for employees from the Hungry Horse, Spotted Bear, and Glacier View Ranger Districts of the Flathead National Forest. Congress authorized the proposed land sale through the Pilot Conveyance Act of 2003 (Public Law 108-7 108th Congress).
