Public Comments Encouraged for Red Whale Environmental Assessment

The Glacier View Ranger District of the Flathead National Forest is requesting public comment on a recently completed environmental assessment (EA) for the Red Whale Project located in the North Fork Flathead River drainage, approximately 30 miles north of Columbia Falls. The project proposes to reduce fuel levels near private property, enhance habitat diversity and security for wildlife species, and provide access across National Forest System lands to a State of Montana section of land.

The environmental assessment identifies four alternatives. Each alternative varies in the number of acres that are managed with mechanical fuels reduction treatments (927- 3,583 acres), prescribed burning (94- 1,509 acres) and road and trail access closures, seasonal and yearlong (4-25 miles).
