Summary of the Proposed 5-year Program of Work

Perceived Niche

The recreation niche we propose is "Water, Wilderness & Wildlife". Sharing the name of the lake and rushing rivers that wind through it, the Flathead NF is a critical piece of an incredible intact ecosystem that sustains the grizzly bear and the quality of human life.

Inventory of Developed Recreation Sites

We currently manage 94 Developed Recreation Sites. They have been distributed into the following categories

- 28 Campgrounds
- 7 Picnic Sites
- 19 Trailheads
- 23 Boating/Swim Sites
- 13 Cabin/Lookout Rentals
- 2 Minor Interp./Observation Sites
- 1 Horse Camp
- 1 Administrative Information Site

Summary of the Proposed Program of Work

After a thorough analysis of each of our 94 Developed Recreation Sites, we have recommended the following actions over the next 5 years:

Change in Season of Operation	74 Sites
New Site Fees	9 Sites
Increase in Existing Fees (cabin rentals and campgrounds)	26 Sites
Remove Facilities and Operate as a Dispersed Site	7 Sites
Increase Services	6 Sites
