

POLLINATION CLUES (BAT) I am attracted to white or pale green flowers that open at night.

The flowers I am attracted to are high off the ground.

I have a strong sense of smell.

BAT FLOWER

INSTRUCTIONS

Cut out the flower pattern along the outer dark line.
Color the flower:


- Color the sepals green.
- Leave the petals white.
- Color the center of the flower yellow.
- 3) Make the pistil:
- Cut out the part labeled "pistil" and color it green or yellow.
- Fold it along the dotted line.
- Tape the folded side onto the pistil in the drawing.
- Cut a square of velcro this size.
- Stick it to the top of the pistil.

- 4) Make the stamens:
- Cut one pipe cleaner in four equal pieces.
- Fold over the tip on each piece.
- Cut two squares of velcro this size.
- Stick them to the folded tips on two of the pipe cleaners.
- Stick the pipe cleaners through the flower around the pistil.
- Stick a yellow pom pom or cotton ball to the velcro squares.
- Tape the ends of the pipe cleaners to the back of the flower.

5) Tape a popsicle stick or ruler to the back of the flower stem to use as a handle.

6) Cut out and tape the Pollination Clues to the back of the flower picture.
