### Brief background: Grant



**View of Vicksburg and plan of the canal, fortifications & vicinity** The Vicksburg campaign was waged from March 29 to July 4, 1863. The surrender of Vicksburg, strategically guarding the Mississippi River, gave the North undisputed control of the Mississippi River. Major General Ulysses Grant directed the Union forces.
