PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on the Cibola National Forest, Bernalillo County, New Mexico.

1. It is prohibited to go into or be upon (the portion of La Luz trail and surrounding area as described in this Order), which is closed for the protection of public health and safety. 36 CFR 261.53 (e) and 261.55 (a)

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED

The restricted area is the upper portion of the La Luz trail (TR 137) between the areas of the upper Sandia Peak Tram terminal and the junction with the Crest Spur trail (TR 84). Exhibit A.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is for the protection of public health and safety because of danger from the trail sloughing during this time frame as well as the slope being covered in snow and ice during this time.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until rescinded or until April 30, 2009, whichever event occurs first.
2. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals, and \$10,000.00 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581].
3. This Order supersedes, rescinds, and replaces any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.
