Testing for Hepatitis C

- Talk to your health care provider about whether you should be tested.
- The <u>ONLY</u> way to tell for sure if you have hepatitis C is a simple and safe blood test.
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Hepatitis C Results

- Accurate 6 months or more after exposure.
- A positive test means you were exposed to the hepatitis C virus <u>at some point</u>.
- Further tests can see if the virus is still in your blood <u>right now</u>. If it is, that means you have hepatitis C.
