## Forest Service Announces Selection of Helena Forest Supervisor

Missoula, MT -- Kevin Riordan was announced today as the new Helena National Forest Supervisor by Northern Regional Forester Gail Kimbell. Riordan replaces former Supervisor Tom Clifford who retired in January.

Riordan, 52, is currently coordinating actions to implement the Ditch Bill easements for the Rocky Mountain region, based in Lakewood, CO. Prior to that assignment, Riordan was the Forest Service liaison with the Western Governor's Association.
