An Air Quality meeting was held last week:

- Attendees: Terry Svalberg (BTNF), Steve Haydon, and Jim Zapert (Air Quality Specialist on behalf of Stanley Energy)
- The BTNF received a proposal from Jim Zapert including an overview of his recommended protocol for the air quality analysis.
- The FS will take into consideration.

#### ARCADIS update (reported by Kathy):

- ARCADIS is waiting to receive electronic files from Pinedale Anticline air impact analysis the EPA determined the draft SEIS was unsatisfactory (presumably due to the air modeling results rather than the methodology used in the analysis). These files were requested through appropriate Forest Service and BLM channels after the Plains Exploration & Production Co. (PXP) Project interagency air stakeholders meeting held in February. Agency staff and the NEPA contractor (ARCADIS) have established a method of transferring the files on external hard drives. The met files and model files are held by two different contractors who worked on the Pinedale Anticline SEIS air analysis. After receiving and reviewing these data, ARCADIS can recommend how to move forward.
- The Air Resource Stakeholder Group (interagency) would come up with a recommendation for the methodology to be used for the air analysis for this project. It is likely that the same or a similar

- methodology as the PXP Project methodology would be used for this project. This group has not been engaged (met) on this project yet.
- External hard drives were sent this week to the air contractors for the Pinedale Anticline SEIS in order for them to transfer the files to ARCADIS.

### RFD development - ongoing

 We received management area NEPA documents and the Supplemental Information Report for the leasing decisions made on the lease parcels by the BTNF. Constraints from these documents will be taken into account to develop RFDS for the project.
