Proposal Name: Ivory Mill Saddle to Snow Mountain OHV Hunting Connectivity

On November 30, 2007, Grindstone District Ranger Eduardo Olmedo signed a decision notice to allow mixed use on a segment of M3 from Ivory Mill Saddle to near West Crockett trailhead. Mixed-use allows use by both highway-legal and non-highway-legal vehicles and drivers. Currently only highway-legal vehicles are allowed. Total length of the segment is about 17.5 miles, and is located in Glenn County, California, about ten miles southwest of the community of Elk Creek.
