

MENDOCINO NATIONAL FOREST NOTICE OF DECISION

Proposal Name: Close Trail 68

On December 14, 2007, Forest Supervisor Tom Contreras signed a decision notice to close and decommission off-highway-vehicle trail #68. Total length of the trail is about 2.7 miles. It is located in northern Lake County, California, about three miles east of Lake Pillsbury.
