

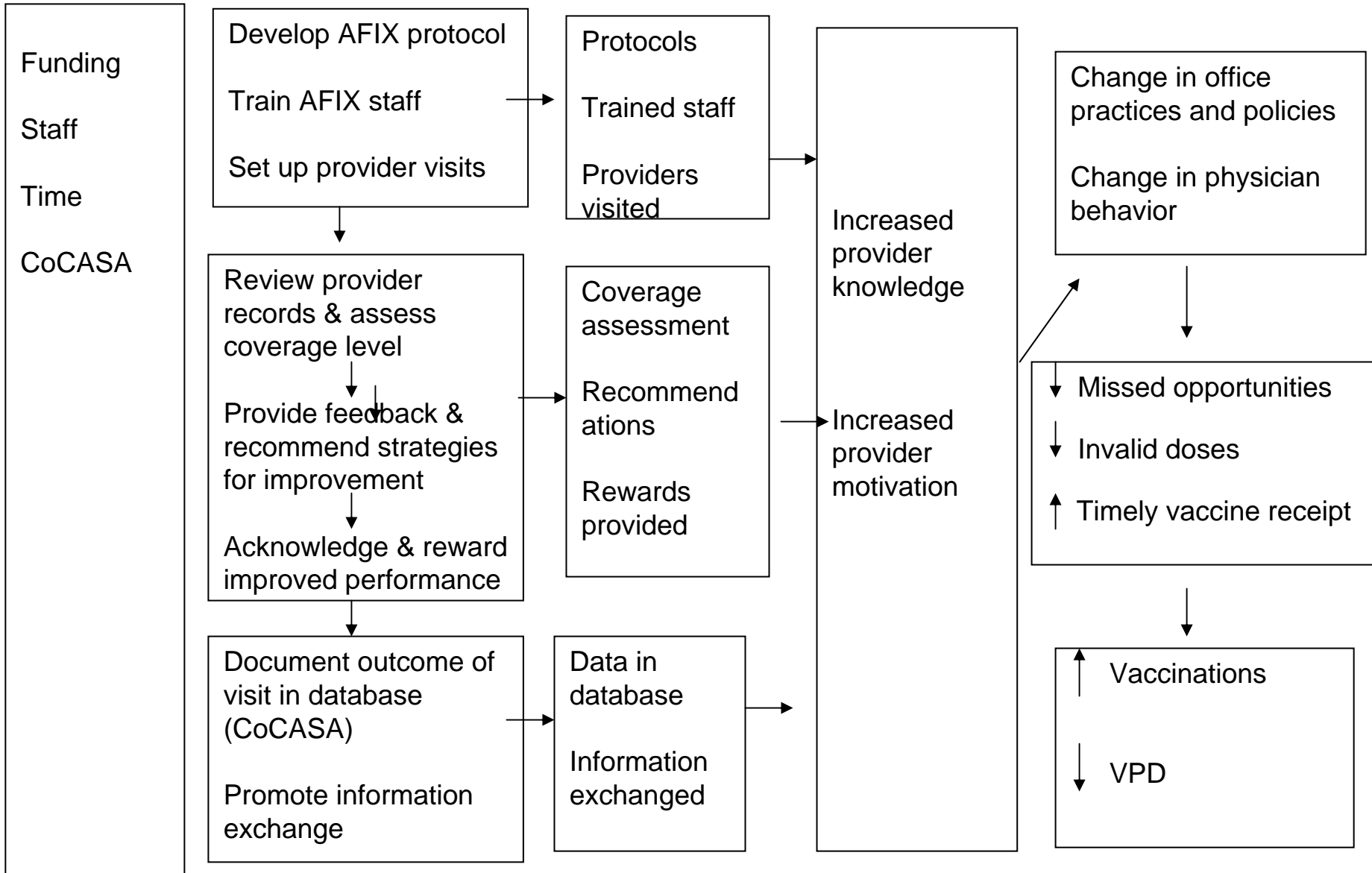

# Examples of SMART Objectives

**Goal: Improve vaccination coverage among children and adolescents in the state through the AFIX program.**

<b>Process</b>	<b>By December 2007, 100% of AFIX field staff in the state will receive training on how to conduct feedback sessions that meet all AFIX Level I standards.</b>
<b>Short-term Outcome</b>	<b>By March 2008, all AFIX staff who participated in the feedback training will report an increase in knowledge about the components of a feedback session including what items need to be included in a quality improvement plan.</b>
<b>Intermediate Outcome</b>	<b>By June 2008, all AFIX staff who participated in the training will include QI plans that contain all key items in their feedback sessions.</b>
<b>Long-term Outcome</b>	<b>By June 2009, the number of providers who implement all recommended interventions by the proposed date will increase by 50%.</b>
