

Order No. 01-08-02

**BEAR CREEK TRAIL
OCCUPANCY AND USE
ANGELES NATIONAL FOREST**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), and to protect natural resources and provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited within the San Gabriel River Ranger District of the Angeles National Forest. This order is effective from March 1, 2008 through February 28, 2009.


Being on Bear Creek Trail (Trail No. 9W10) from the trailhead located at California Highway 39, mile marker 32.12 then south for 2.6 miles as shown in Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions contained in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
