ORDER NO. 01-07-04 OCCUPANCY AND USE ANGELES NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to protect the public, the following acts are prohibited within the Angeles National Forest. This order is in effect from October 23, 2007, through the end of the official fire season.

- 1. Going into or being upon any National Forest System lands within the Angeles National Forest. 36 CFR 261.53(e).
- 2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Angeles National Forest. 36 CFR 261.54(c).
- 3. Being on any National Forest System trails within the Angeles National Forest. 36 CFR 261.55(a)

Pursuant to 36CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 3. Owners or lessees of land within the closure area are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.
- 4. Persons who reside within the closure area are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
