Purpose

Rehabilitation Outcomes Research Center of Excellence - Gainesville, Florida

Research Career Development awards are for fully trained clinicians who are early in their research career. These awards provide mentoring and research support from 2 - 5 years of concentrated health services research activity, for each award. The Career Development awards are for those who need additional mentoring to become fully independent researchers. The four types of awards are the Career Development Award-1 (CDA-1), Career Development Award-2 (CDA-2), Career Development Transition Award (CDTA), and Career Development Enhancement Award (CDEA).

Funding Support

CDA-1 – Two years of salary support (non-clinicians) **\$51,972**; (clinicians) **Appointed under Title 38**

CDA-2 – Three-Five years of salary support (non-clinicians) **\$74,074**; (clinicians) **Appointed under Title 38**

CDTA – Three years of salary support (VA clinicians) **Appointed under Title 38**

CDEA – Six years of salary support (VA clinicians) **Appointed under Title 38**

Eligibility

- **U.S. Citizen**
- **CDA-1**; suggested academic rank is Instructor (non-clinicians): no more than 2 years beyond PhD (clinicians); no more than 2 years beyond clinical training
- **CDA-2**; suggested academic rank is Assistant Professor (non-clinicians): no more than 5 years beyond PhD (clinicians): no more than 5 years beyond clinical training
- **CDTA**; suggested academic rank is Associate Professor (VA clinicians): no more than 10 years beyond clinical fellowship
- **CDEA**; suggested academic rank is Associate Professor (VA clinicians): 100% time to research
