

# Iraqi War Veteran Data Assumptions

- Current data is not used in the forecasts but will be included in FY06
- The model incorporates 38% of National Guard and Reserves called to active duty for the OIF/OEF conflicts since they were previously enrolled
- Total veteran deaths are 700,000 per year, which are not offset by the 290,000 separations
- VA contractor will test if there is a 10% difference in forecast demand
