Wright's Creek Prescribed Burn

Fire Name/Unit	Wright's Creek Prescribed burn on the Mi-Wok Ranger District
General Location	The prescribed burn consists of 1 unit located 4 miles south of Long Barn in the Tuolumne River drainage near Fahey Meadow north of Marble Mountain.
Size and type of Prescribed Burn	This fall approximately 100 acres will be treated with low intensity fire.
Prescribed Fire Manager	Jerry McGowan, Forest Fire Management Officer
Planned Implementation & Duration	Planned implementation date is scheduled near the end of October. The burn days will vary slightly, contingent on weather, burn day status, and available fire suppression resources.
Prescribed Burn Objectives	The primary objectives of the burn is to protect plantation units and improve deer habitat by reducing the hazardous vegetation in the understory.
Resource Benefits	Promote forest health, reduce the vegetation, and provide protection to the public and firefighters.
Public Notice	Smoke will be visible along the Highway 108 corridor. There will be smoke in the canyons during the early morning and night. If you have health problems please contact the Mi-Wok Ranger District at (209) 586-3234. We will notify you in advance of the prescribed fires.
