Peake assumed his position as Secretary of Veterans Affairs last December and is the principal advocate for veterans in the federal government. A St. Louis, Mo. native, Peake is a West Point Graduate and also served proudly in Vietnam with the 101st Airborne Division and was awarded the Silver Star, a Bronze Star with "V" device and the Purple Heart with oak leaf cluster. Later, he earned his medical degree at Cornell University and began his Army medical career as a general surgery resident at Brooke Army Medical Center at Fort Sam Houston in Texas. He retired from the Army in 2004, following service

as a cardiac surgeon and commander in several medical posts, culminating in his appointment as U.S. Army Surgeon General from 2000 to 2004. He also served as Commanding General of the U.S. Army Medical Department Center and School, the largest medical training facility in the world.

Secretary Peake will celebrate the success of the Summer Sports Clinic at the Closing Ceremonies tonight at the Marriott Coronado Terrace. We are honored he could be part of the inauguration of what is sure to be a great addition to VA's excellent rehabilitation events focused on helping our nation's veterans.
