





PUBLIC NOTICE Tahoe National Forest LINDSEY LAKE ACCESS ROAD AND CAMPGROUND CLOSURE ORDER NO. 17-05-01

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to protect natural resources and public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Yuba River Ranger District of the Tahoe National Forest. This order is effective from July 13, 2005 through September 15, 2005.

- 1. Using a motor vehicle on the Lindsey Lake Road (Forest Road No. 17) from the gate that is located about one-third of a mile east of its intersection with Loney Meadows Road (Forest Road No. 17-8) to its termination point. 36 CFR 261.54(a). For the purpose of this order, a wheelchair is not considered to be a motor vehicle. A wheelchair is defined in the Americans with Disabilities Act to be "a device solely for use by a mobility-impaired person for locomotion that is suitable for use in an outdoor pedestrian area." 42 USC 12207(c)(2).
- 2. Camping within the Lindsey Lake Campground. 36 CFR 261.58(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A. Done at Nevada City, California, this 13th day of July, 2005.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581
