Sugar Pine Area Trail Closures

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), and for the protection of public health and safety, the following acts are prohibited within the American River Ranger District of the Tahoe National Forest. This order is effective from August 24, 2005, through November 30, 2005.

Being on the National Forest System trails listed below:

1. Forest Trail No. 11E41 (Loop 3)(see attached map).
2. Forest Trail No. 11E42 (Loop 4)(see attached map).
36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

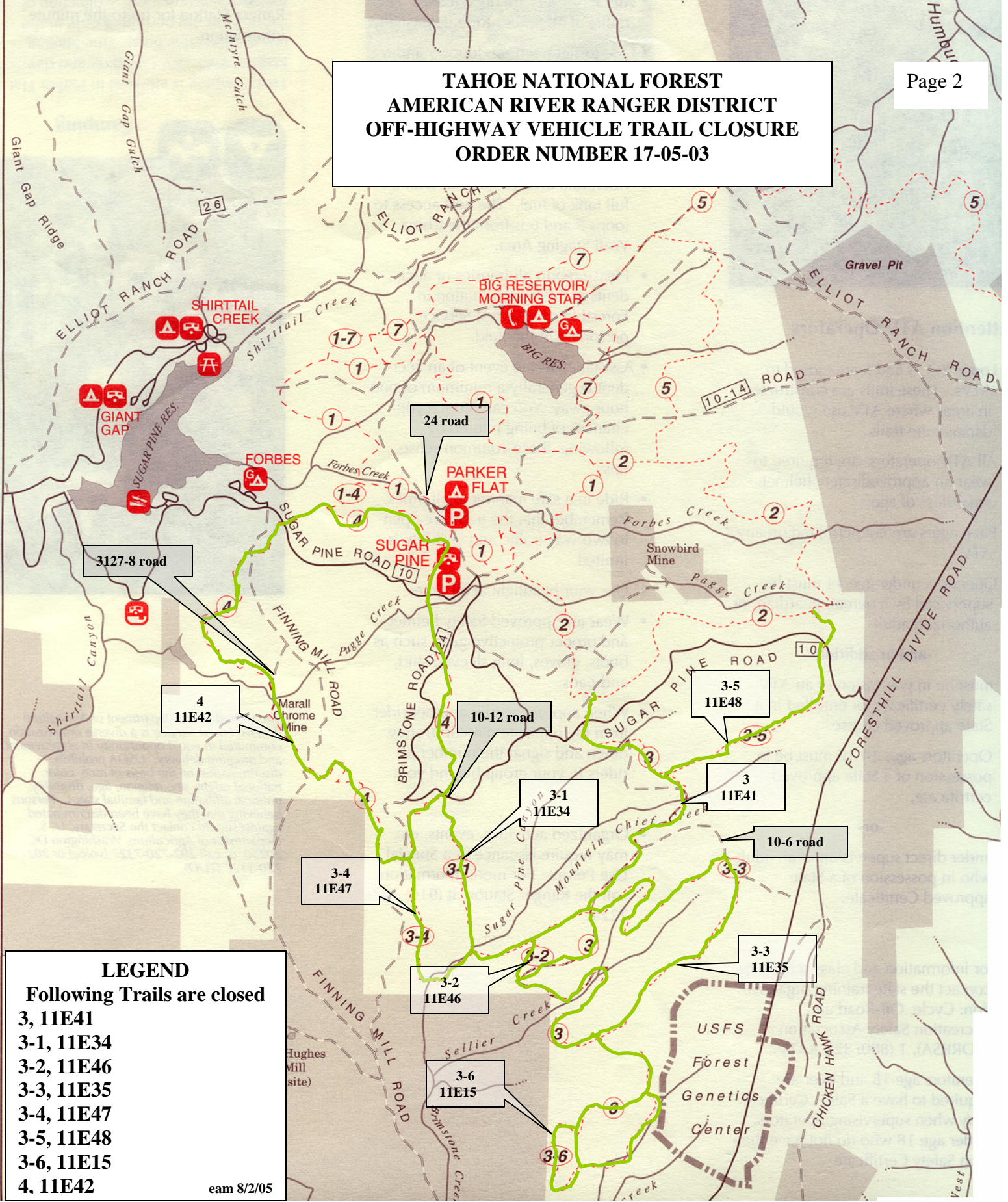

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.

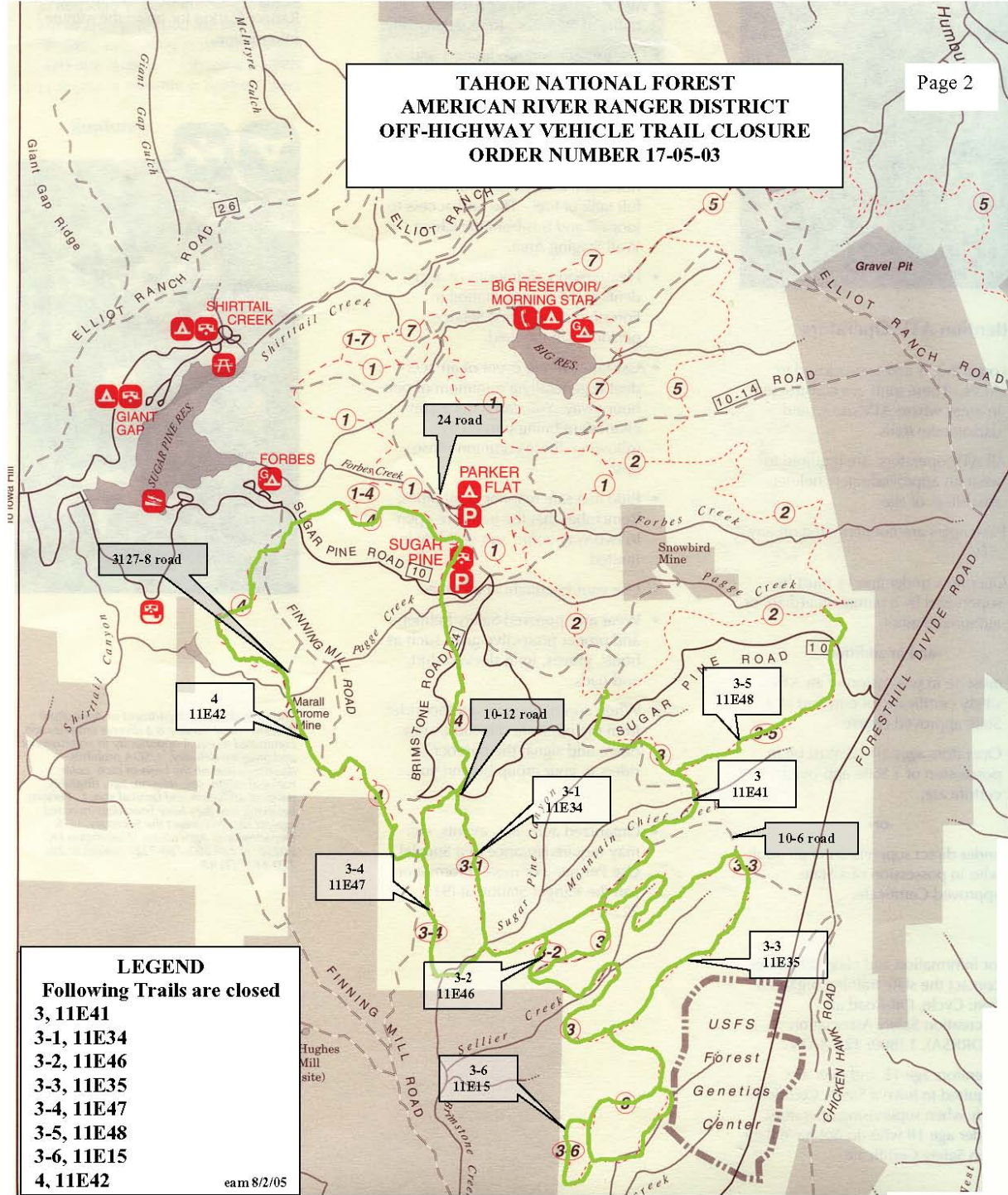
