



## PUBLIC NOTICE Tahoe National Forest Boca Special Closure ORDER NO. 17-96-209

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) & (b), I prohibit the following acts on these forest lands and forest development roads within the special closure area, as shown on Exhibit 1, for protection of an endangered species.

- 1. Going into or being upon the Closure Area. 36 CFR 261.53(a).
- 2. Using any type of motorized or mechanized vehicle or equipment. 36 CFR 261.54(a).

## This order applies from January 1 to August 31 of each calendar year.

The following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force or employee of a public utility in the performance of an official duty.
- 2. Persons with a permit issued by the District Ranger. This permit must specifically authorize the otherwise prohibited act of omission and must by in possession while in the closed area.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261.
