



## Order No. 17-06-03 Food Storage USDA Forest Service Yuba River Ranger District

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to protect natural resources and public safety, the following act is prohibited within the Yuba River Ranger District of the Tahoe National Forest. This order is effective from May 1, 2006, through April 30, 2008.

Possessing or storing any food or refuse within a developed recreation site in a manner which allows bears, coyotes, or other wild animals access to such food or refuse. 36 CFR 261.58(cc).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions contained in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
