### 1. VHA Issues Notice on Sharing Rehabilitation Data

The VHA has issued a notice (#2000-04, November 21, 2002) entitled "Protocol For Sharing VA Rehabilitation Outcomes Data With VA And Non-VA Research Investigators." The Notice describes the protocol by which the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and non-VA researchers may access data stored in the Functional Status and Outcomes Database (FSOD) (for Rehabilitation) at the Austin Automation Center (AAC). # 2. Research Representatives Helping Draft HIPAA-Required Notice

Health services researchers are represented by staff from VACO and VIReC on the VHA task force developing a Notice of Privacy Practices that will give patients details about the ways in which the organization uses or discloses information about its patients. The notice is required by the HIPAA Privacy Rule and will be mailed to all VHA beneficiaries by the compliance deadline of April 14, 2003.
