#### D.2 EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

Equipment shall be maintained in good repair by the Contractor.

##### D.2.1 Contractor Provided Equipment

- OSHA-required personal protective equipment.
- Modules are hired wet and rate includes tow vehicles.

#### D.3 PERSONNEL REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum of two personnel. Contractor personnel are responsible for operating the equipment and feeding the materials into the chipper.
- RT-130 Annual Fireline Refresher including fire shelter is required.\*

\*Nomex PPE will be provided by the Government in accordance with D.7.1.3.

#### a. Payment.

- i. **Daily Rate** - Payment will be made on basis of calendar days (0001 – 2400). For fractional days at the beginning and ending of time under hire, payment will be based on 50 percent of the Daily Rate for periods less than 8 hours.
  - 1) Payment of the daily rate for travel to and from the incident and between incidents will be calculated as follows: Travel miles from point of hire / 45 mph (ref. D.6.5.2) / 11 hours X daily rate.
