1. FY2005 DSS Identifiers and Three-Tier Co-payment Rates for Outpatient Services

VHA has established a three-tier co-payment for outpatient services with VHA Directive 2004-062, "Implementation Of Changes For Co-Payments For Outpatient Medical Care Provided to Veterans by the Department of Veterans Affairs," issued November 3, 2004. The directive specifies the DSS Identifiers (stop codes) to be used for FY2005 and the co-payments, if any, for each. 2. Directive on "VHA Site Tracking (VAST) System"

Policy on use and management of the VHA Site Tracking System, known as VAST, is delineated in VHA Directive 2004-060 issued October 28, 2004. The directive describes the processes and division of labor among offices by which the VAST System is to function. Official definitions of various facility types (e.g., VA hospital, Vet Center, CBOC, etc.) are provided in appendices. 3. VHA Issues Operating Procedures for Use of VA Medicare Data

VHA Directive 2004-063, "Operating Procedures for the Management of Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services Data," was issued November 3, 2004. It formalizes the role VIReC has been playing for the past year in the VA Medicare Data Merge Initiative as the unique manager and distributor for VA-Medicare linked data files to VA researchers. It also formalizes the designation of an Oversight Team formed by the Assistant Deputy Under Secretary for Health (ADUSH) to ensure data security and compliance with policies and regulations regarding use of the data.
