 the Forest was compiled from B.M. data, 2007 field reviews.

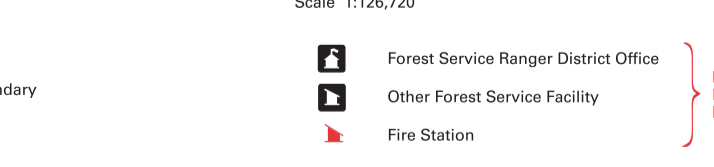
