

Push for Multi-year awards

 To initiate, PIs must submit statements of work and budgets for each year of project. Subsequent years only need revised detailed budget and statement of work (if revisions required), Program Office submits obligating document to GMD to award next budget period.

 - Acceptance of satisfaction for a programmatic Special Award Condition
 - Approval of SF-270, Request of Advance or Reimbursement, for reimbursements
- Modification of financial status reports requirements
 - GMD now only requires SF-269 (Financial Status Report), not SF-272 (Federal Cash Transactions Report)





- A direct interface to other systems such as the CAMS/ASAP (financial systems), FinLitLog (legal system)


Current Mail Process is too slow and exceptionally labor-intensive

Grants Online's Conceptual System Model


