SUBJECT: Part 135 Operational Control Questions & Answers (Q&As)

Purpose: To provide operators with a web document that addresses commonly asked questions regarding 14 CFR part 135 operational control.

Background: In cooperation with the National Air Transportation Association (NATA), the National Business Aviation Association (NBAA), and several industry participants, the FAA has provided responses to an industry-developed list of questions (Q&As) pertaining to 14 CFR part 135 operational control issues.
