

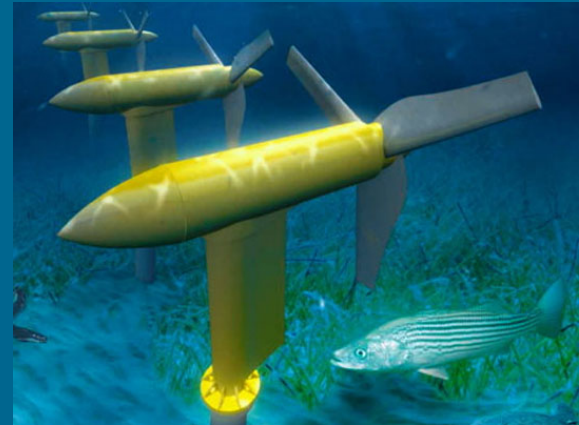

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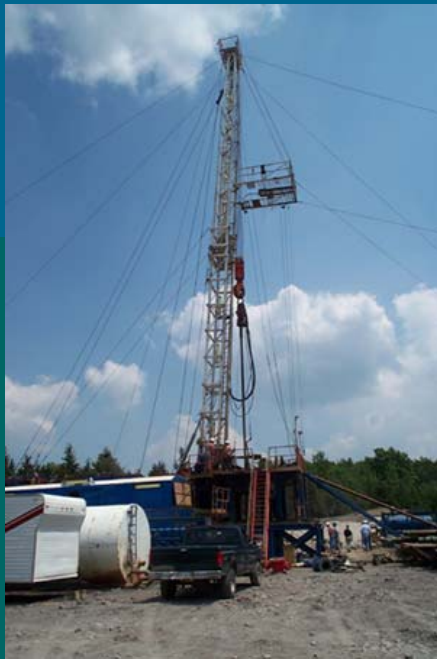
Alternative energy projects

- LNG imports

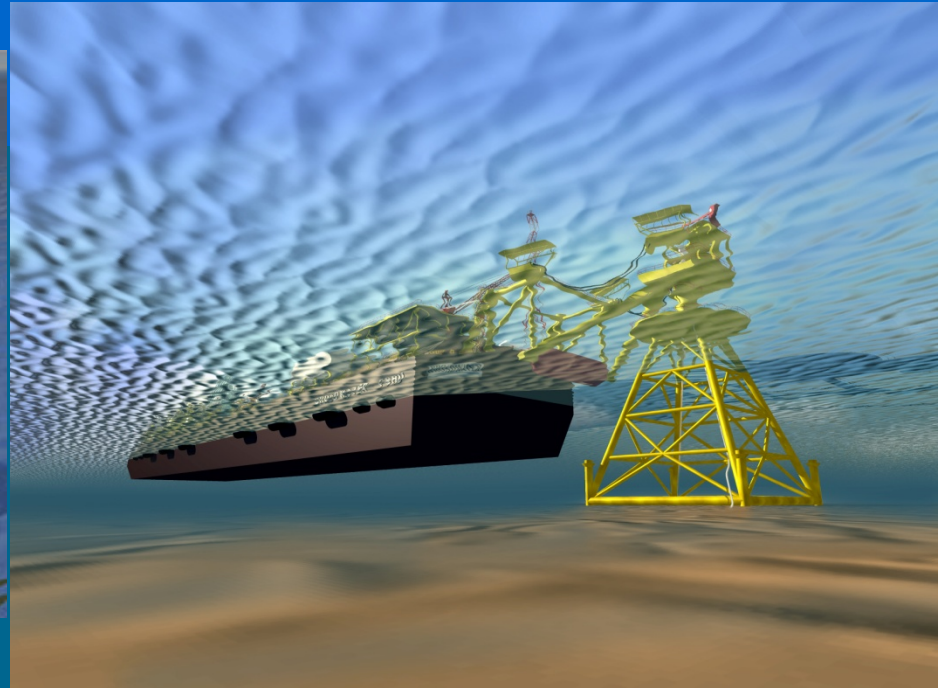


Broadwater proposal

- Floating Storage Regasification Unit anchored in LIS – 9 miles from NY, 11 miles from CT
- 21.3 mile submerged 30" gas pipeline
- 2 – 3 shipments per week
- Supply 1 bcfd to NY and CT

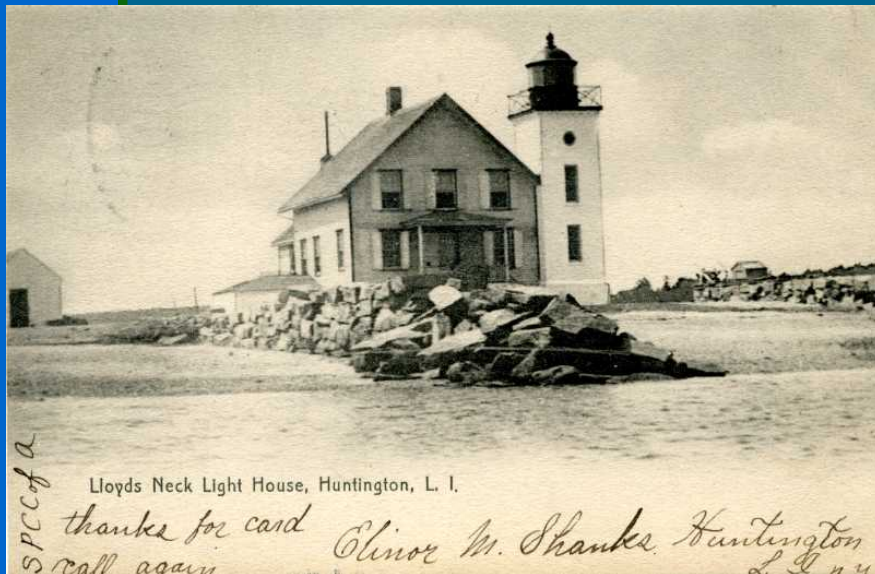


FSRU



- 1,215 ft. long
- 200 ft wide
- 100 ft above the water line
- Exclusion zone around the FSRU is 1.5 sq. mi.

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Policy 9: Provide for public access to, and rec. use of, coastal waters, public lands, and public resources



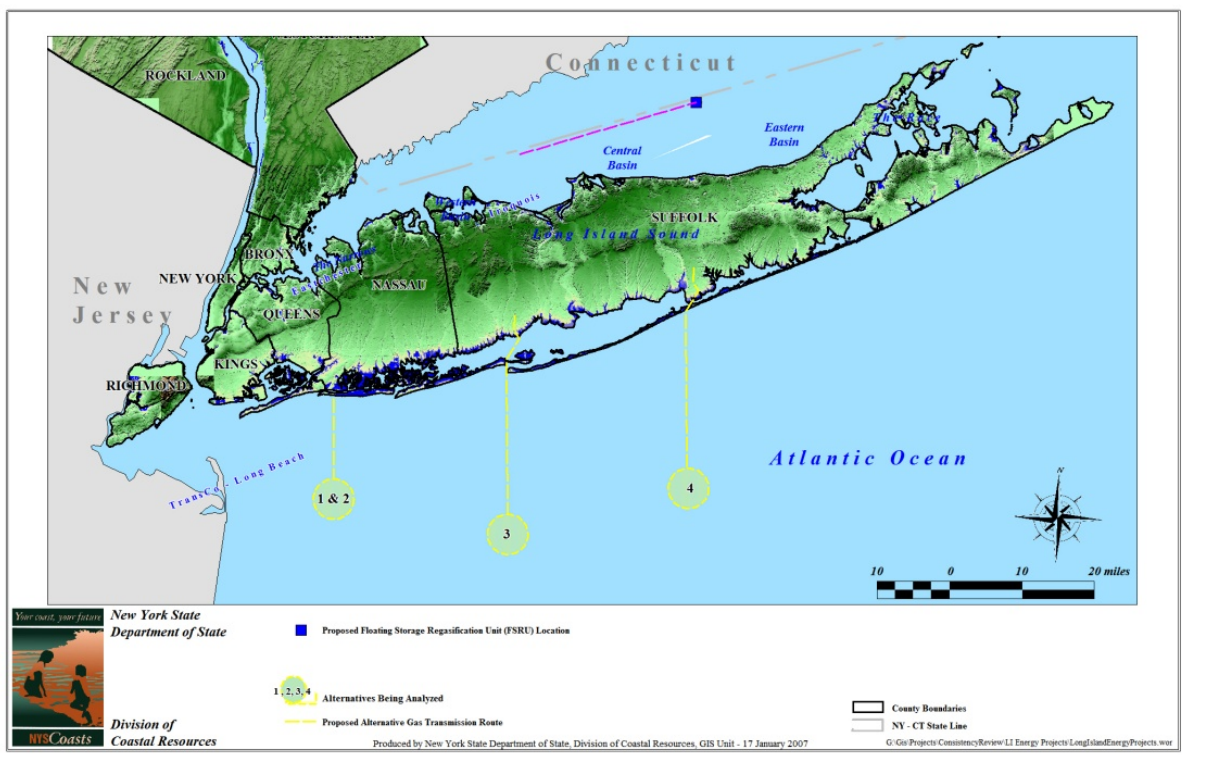
Policy 10: Protect water-dependent uses and site new water-dependent uses in suitable locations

Alternative siting



- Atlantic Ocean, connect to Transco pipeline into Long Beach
- Atlantic Ocean, off Fire Island, along causeway, to Commack

Appeal Process

- Notice of appeal
- 30 days – publish in Federal Register, public/agency comment period open, appellant's brief & appendices
- 60 days – State's brief & appendices, comment period closes, hearing requests received
- 80 days – appellant's reply brief
- 190 days – notice of closing record
- 250 – 265 days – issues decision
