





Weather Monitoring

Provides nowcasts and forecasts to incident teams on tropical storm/hurricane development, conditions in tropical zones, and storm surge warnings.

Hydrographic Surveys/Ports

Surveys rivers and ports to ensure waterways are clear of hazards. Provides information for critical ports and harbors to open for commercial and emergency vessel traffic.

Hazardous Materials Response

Works with Federal, State and local agencies to identify, assess, prioritize, and mitigate oil and hazardous material spills. Provides guidance on vessel salvage, conducting shoreline cleanup assessments, and collecting information to assess impacts to natural resource from spills.

High Resolution Aerial Photography

Provides access routes for navigation response teams, spill response prioritization, search and rescue and public information.

Satellite Imagery

Provides data to monitor, detect and assess environmental change. Relays information from remote sensing platform to local users.

Contaminant Transport/Modeling

Provides forecasts of waterborne/airborne pollution transport of hazardous materials.




