#### Identifying Issues

- Coastal program concerns
- Local government concerns
- Outreach to potential stakeholders

#### Types of outreach

- Speakers bureau
- Council meetings
- Fact sheets
- Individual-small group meetings
- Workshops

#### Speakers Bureau

- Ensure all issues can be presented
- Each section should have a speaker in the pool
- Keep your audience broadly defined
- Develop a collection of presentations that can be given and marketed
- Keep same format and style throughout presentations

## Council Meetings

- Agenda item vs. public comment period
- Know Council background and history
- Provide hard copy information
- Include follow-up opportunity and contact information

#### Fact Sheets

- One page
- To the point
- Bullet take home points
- Provide contact information
- Use same format and style for all sheets

## Individual – small group meetings

- No more than two hours
- No more than eight people
- Limit number of topics to be discussed
- Distribute agenda beforehand

## Workshop Tips

- Send invitations 4-6 weeks ahead
- Personal invitations
- Call 2-3 weeks ahead
- Ensure easy access and parking
- Partner if possible to expand audience
- Provide food and drink, comfortable atmosphere

- Morning vs. Afternoon
- Registration






