I received the flyer from Centennial Airport and understand the FAA has begun their 180 day review of Centennial Airport's FAR Part 150 Noise Exposure & Land Use Compatibility Program. Since the FAA is soliciting comments from interested parties until April 22, 2008. Please log my this email as my families official concerns for the noise and safety issues at Centennial Airport.

For background: I and my family are residents of Heritage Hills in Lone Tree and are 12 year residents of Lone Tree, previously living in the sub-division The Fairways 39. Over the years the noise and I believe safety issues have increased at least 15 fold over this period. I and my wife were active callers over the years as we and our infant children now ages 6 and 9 would be awoken from the noise from airplanes taking off and landing at Centennial Airport. But we never believed the calls voicing our concerns were taken seriously or too much avail and it has only continued to get worse and worse.

With the continued growth within Lone Tree and the surrounding areas not only is the noise of great concern but the new Lone Tree Elementary School opened August of 07 and new Regional Sky Ridge Hospital plus the planning of another Douglas County elementary school (on the planning board for opening in the 2010 school year) for the Ridge Gate area near the Hospital.

Please change the flight paths of all airplanes for the safety of both the school(s) and Hospital. With the recent crashes on approach to Centennial I fear for the safety of all children attending this and future schools in the Centennial Airport area. Not to mention the high rise Sky Ridge hospital. Please change the flight take off and landing and banking paths for the safety of everyone.
