We strongly object to any increase in noise from the Centennial Airport for our CPN (Castle Pines North) community. It appears that recommendation No. 6 caters to the homeowners in Lone Tree and Highlands Ranch that bought their homes knowing the existing level of noise by the planes from Centennial Airport. Now you plan to have the noise transferred to those homeowners in CPN (castle pines north) who bought their homes based on the LACK of airport noise. That will unfairly lowering property values and the quality of life for residents in CPN. Lone Tree and Highlands Ranch were well aware of the existing airport noise when they purchased their property. Owners of CPN live in CPN because they do not like airport noise. That is why we drive the extra 5 -10 minutes south compared to Lone Tree and Highlands Ranch. Recommendation No 6 to move the noise from existing areas and transfer it to areas that previously never experienced airport noise is a grievous error.
