After reading articles recently in the Rocky Mountain News and the Denver Post, we have been very concerned about the proposed changes in flight patterns of aircraft from Centennial Airport. We just can't believe that the FAA would approve flight plans heading over Aurora and Centennial involving flying over more homes than the flight plans being used currently. Does it not make sense that even more noise complaints will be registered if that is allowed to happen? Reduce the evening noise by using a flight plan headed over the industrial area near Centennial Airport, not over the roofs of additional homes. If the newspaper articles were correct, most of the recent noise complaints are from a small number of homes (five homes). They do have the right to complain, but there must be a better solution than annoying thousands of additional homeowners and taxpayers.
