

Regarding the Centennial Airport in Colorado Part 150 Study, I would like to offer my input:

Ban the noisiest aircraft. I support this recommendation.

Allow more departures over Aurora, Colorado. I strongly oppose this recommendation. Centennial Airport serves all of the Denver area. Why should one city in the metro area bear a greater share of the noise?

Route more daytime departures over Aurora. I strongly oppose this recommendation.

Install noise monitoring system and develop a program to evaluate it. A weak proposal, but I can support it.

Work with pilots in a voluntary program to mitigate the noisiest flight patterns. I support this recommendation.

The neighborhoods surrounding Centennial Airport to the north are upper income. Specifically, Greenwood Village and parts of south Denver. Because of this, some of these recommendations smack of elitism and should be rejected out of hand.

Once again, Centennial Airport serves all of Denver. The noise burden should be shared by all.
