My husband and I work and live near Centennial Airport. Before we bought our home, to the west of the supposed flight pattern, we were assured that the correct flight pattern of both incoming and outgoing aircraft was over the Cherry Creek reservoir. Many flights follow that plan, and I have no issue with those planes. A few years ago, I tried several times to complain about the flights that come directly over our house from the west, and found myself in a voice mail run-around. It was disconcerting as the aircraft are more than a half-mile off course at that point.

If you are considering limiting traffic into the airport—the night traffic and the traffic off-course are the most annoying in this neighborhood. When they are that close, they are very noisy. There is so much traffic on Monday and Friday, that the planes that are not flying on course seem to be dangerous to those that are on route.

I appreciate the opportunity to speak, and hope the decisions that will be made are wise for the neighborhood.
